Washington DC Sightseeing

Two Day Hop-on/off Tour. See the sights of Washington, D.C. aboard an open-top double-decker bus. This tour operates as a hop-on, hop-off tour that encompasses 3 different routes for easy navigation of the city and over 50 Sightseeing Stops throughout the nation's capital to reach any destination. Enjoy the luxury and comfort of new equipment with a 24 or 48 hour unlimited hop on hop off ticket. Daily - First departure is at 9am from Union Station and last departure is at 5pm except for the twilight tour. Every 20- 30 minutes.

Washington After Dark Tour. See our national monuments and federal buildings flooded in lights, from the illuminated dome of the US Capitol to the The Kennedy Center, Library of Congress, Supreme Court, House and Senate Office Buildings, Federal Triangle, Pennsylvania Avenue, The White House, Capitol Reflecting Pool, Georgetown, Marine Corps (Iwo Jima) Memorial, and the World War II Memorial. We will make stops at the Jefferson Memorial, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam Memorial, Korean Memorial, and FDR Memorial. You will be fully captivated during this three-hour tour.

Hop-On, Hop-Off Washington DC Night Tour. Join us for a 2.5 hour fully narrated tour with a live guide to the FDR Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam Veteran, Korean War Memorial, Iwo Jima Memorial, The White House, Union Station and much more. The tour begins at Union Station at 6:30 PM, with a 6 PM pickup at the Willard Hotel. See all the major DC landmarks and monuments lit up at night. The 2.5 hour tour includes stop-offs at key landmarks. Make the most of the fantastic, unobstructed views from the top of the bus for the best photo opportunities in the city.

Arlington Cemetery/Mt. Vernon/Alexandria/Tour. Board Arlington National Cemetery's lectured tram to the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and view the unforgettable Changing of the Guard ceremony. Witness the eternal flame that lights up the Kennedy Gravesite. Stop for a photo opportunity at Iwo Jima Memorial, Pentagon Memorial, and Air Force Memorial. DC in a Day Tour. Visit the Capitol building Visitor's Center for an orientation period. There will be a photo stop at the White House (south lawn) and a visit to the White House Visitor Center, which houses the same decor and information about past and present Presidents. Head to the World War II Memorial, visit the world famous Smithsonian Museums and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial! You will not want to miss the Air and Space Museum or the American History Museum. You will also see the FBI Building, Federal Triangle, Ellipse, Tidal Basin, world famous Cherry Blossom Trees, National Archives, Washington Monument, U.S. Botanical Gardens, National Gallery of Art, U.S. Navy Memorial and Grant Memorial

Day Trip to Monticello. Departure 8:00 a.m. from Gray Line Terminal at Union Station. Reservations required by 3pm the previous day. Travel to Charlottesville, Virginia and visit Monticello, home of Thomas Jefferson, President, inventor, surveyor, musician and artist. We will also tour the famous Michie Tavern, with the option to purchase lunch on your own. The Thomas Jefferson Visitor Center and Smith Education Center, the new gateway to Monticello, will offer visitors greatly enhanced services and amenities while engaging them in Thomas Jefferson's life, times, and lasting legacies through a new introductory film, four innovative exhibitions, and a hands-on discovery room.

Day Trip to Gettysburg. Departure 8:00 a.m. from Gray Line Terminal at Union Station. Reservations required by 3pm the previous day. Travel through picturesque country to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, a town steeped in historic interest. The day is devoted to a tour of the town and the historic battlefield. The Gettysburg Diorama, one of the largest Miniature Military Dioramas in the United States, gives a narrated history of the Battle, accompanied by sound and light effects. The commentary of your tour guides will help you understand, more clearly than ever before, the story of the largest battle ever fought on U.S. soil. View Cemetery Ridge, where Abraham Lincoln delivered his famous Gettysburg Address. Visit the restored home of George Washington Shriver and see where Confederate sharpshooters were killed and where Civil War bullets and medical equipment were discovered 133 years later. We will stop near General Pickett's where you can enjoy lunch on your own.
